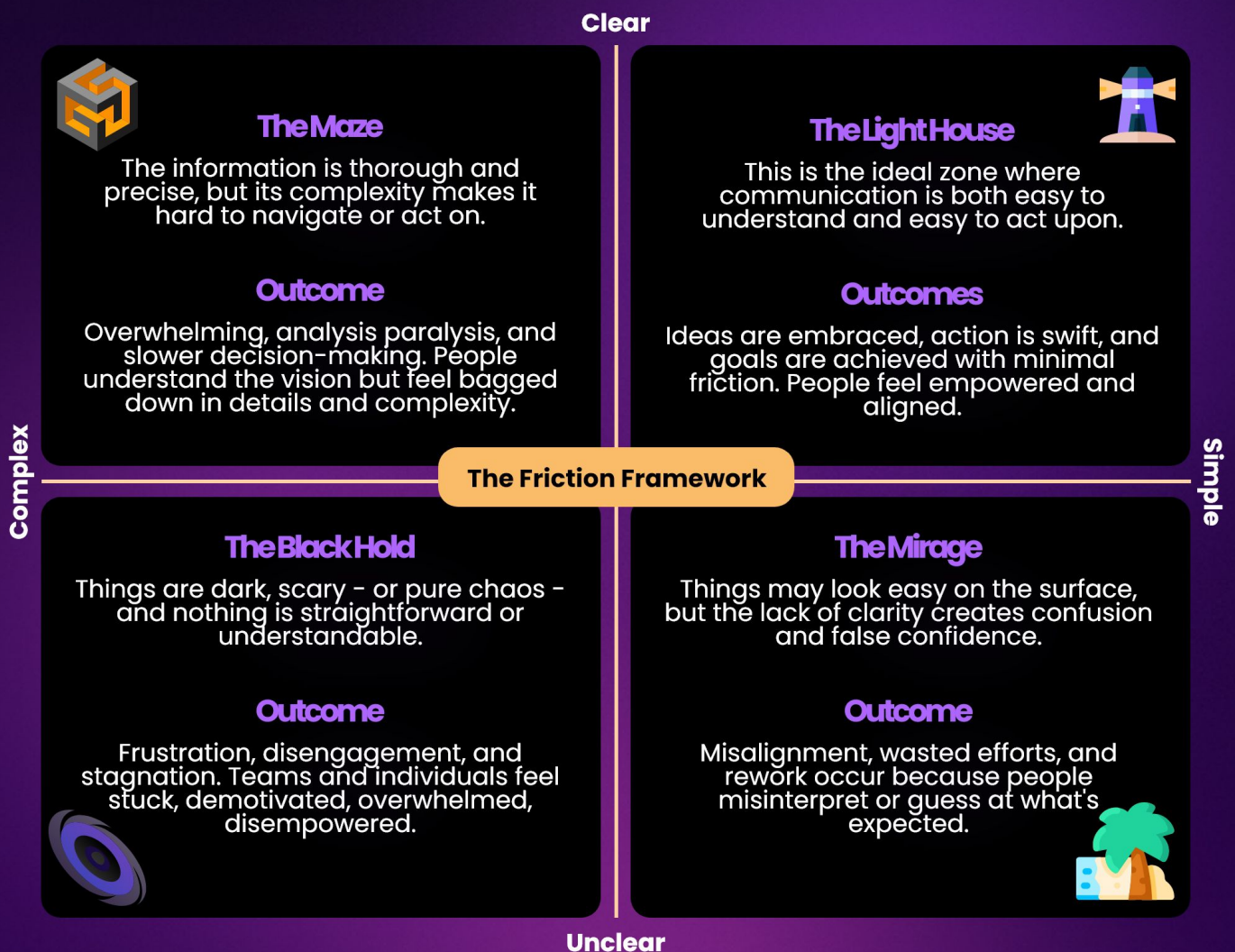




Simplify and Clarify

Top 10 Teaching Points

01

Leadership as Influence

Inspire and guide through clarity and focus, not titles.

02

Simplification & Clarification

Simplify complexity into key parts; clarify details to ensure understanding and action.

03

Find the Lighthouse

Balance simplicity with actionable detail for effective communication.

04

Prioritize for Impact

Focus on the 20% of tasks driving 80% of results (Pareto Principle).

05

Tell Stories

Use relatable examples to make complex ideas engaging and easy to grasp.

06

Provide Context

Explain the "why" behind actions to connect efforts to larger goals.

07

Define Outcomes

Be specific about success (e.g., "Increase retention by 15% in Q1").

08

Use Frameworks

Apply tools like F.I.R.S.T. (Focus, Impact, Relevance, Simplicity, Timeliness) to guide decisions.

09

Combat Complexity

Use visuals to simplify ideas and avoid vague instructions.

10

Clarify Without Micromanaging

Set expectations clearly while allowing autonomy.
